

# Time Rabbit Double Knitting Pattern

As part of our campaign to raise awareness about the challenges posed by long parental absences, The Naval Children's Charity is delighted to invite you to create these Time Rabbits.

These will be sent out, alongside the original work of children's literature "Zoe and the Time Rabbit", to families that have requested them.

The time rabbits come in pairs – one with a happy face on the tummy, and one with a sad face.

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### **MEASUREMENT**

Approx 16-17 cm from tip of feet to the top of the head (excluding ears)

# **EQUIPMENT**

Pair 3.25mm knitting needles Needle to sew up rabbit Large-eyed embroidery needle

#### **MATERIALS**

25g Double Knitting yarn in bright yellow (eg King Cold Dollymix in Gold)
Small amount of polyester toy stuffing
Small amounts of red and black dk or 4ply yarn (or you could use embroidery thread)

## **ABBREVIATIONS**

Inc 1 – Increase by knitting into front and back of next stitch

K - Knit

K2tog - knit next 2 sts together

M1 – make one by picking up loop between st on needle and next st and knitting into back P – Purl Psso – pass slip stitch over (knit st)

P2tog - purl the next 2 stitches together

P2tog tbl – purl the next 2 stitches together through the back of loops

St/sts - stitch/stitches

St st - stocking stitch - alternate rows of knit and purl

SII - slip next st without knitting it

#### **BODY AND HEAD**

Knitted in one piece from base of body to top of head

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Cast on 20 sts
R1 - K3, inc1, K1, inc1, K7, inc1, K1, inc1, K4 (24 sts)
R2 - P
R3 - K5, M1, K2, M1, K10, M1, K2, M1, K5 (28 sts)
R5 - K6, M1, K2, M1, K12, M1, K2, M1, K6 (32 sts)
R6 - P
Work 10 rows in st st beginning with a K row.
R17 – *K1, [K2tog] 3 times, K2, [sl1, K1, psso]3 times, K1. Repeat from * (20 sts)
R18 - P1, P2tog, P2tog tbl, P1, P2tog, P2tog, P2tog tbl, P2tog tbl, P1, P2tog, P2tog, P1 (12 sts)
R19 - K
R20 - P
R21 - [K1, M1] 5 times, K2, [M1, K1] 5 times (22 sts)
R22 - P
R23 - [K2, M1] twice, K3, M1, K2, M1, K4, M1, K2, M1, K3 [M1, K2] twice (30 sts)
Work 7 rows st st beginning with P row
R31 - K2, [K2tog, K1] twice, K1, [S1, K1, psso, K1] twice, K1, [K1, K2tog] twice, [K1, S1, K1, psso] twice, K2 (22 sts)
R32 - [P1, P2tog] repeat to last st, P1 (15 sts)
Cast off
LEGS (knitted from top of thigh to tip of foot)
Make x2
Cast on 10 sts
Work 6 rows in st st beginning with a k row
R7 - K2, M1, K3, M1, K3, M1, K2 (13 sts)
Work 7 rows in st st beginning with a p row
R15 - [SI1, K1, psso] 3 times, K1, [K2tog] 3 times (6 sts)
Break yarn, thread it through remaining sts, pull up and fasten securely
ARMS (knitted from top of arm to tip of hand)
Make x2
Cast on 9 sts
Work 12 rows in st st beginning with a k row
R13 - [sl1, K1, psso] twice, K1 [K2tog] twice (5 sts)
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Break yarn, thread it through remaining sts, pull up and fasten securely

EARS (knitted from base to tip)
Make x2
Cast on 4 sts
Knit 14 rows
R15 – SI1, K1, psso, K2tog (2 sts)
R16 – P2tog
Fasten off

#### MAKING UP

Sew edges of body and head together (centre back seam). Close seam at top of head. Stuff head and body, sew up seam at base of body.

Sew back seams of arms and legs, leaving top edges open. Stuff fairly lightly. Sew arms in place, just to the front rather than exactly on the sides. Sew legs in place. Sew ears in place.

Use black yarn (or embroidery thread) to embroider 2 French knots for eyes and one French knot for nose. Embroider a straight st for the mouth.

Use red yarn (or embroidery thread) to embroider a circle in chain st on the rabbits tummy for a clock face. Add French knots for the eyes and work a flattened 'v' in straight st for the smiley mouth or an upside-down flattened 'v' for the sad mouth.
